Health Insurance Options for Part-Time Faculty/Staff/Adjunct Faculty and Dependents

While the Commonwealth of Virginia and George Mason University do not formally offer health insurance to part-time employees, health insurance options do exist for employees and their dependents who wish to purchase individual and family Health Insurance plans. If you and/or your dependents enroll in one of the health plans below, you will be responsible for paying the entire insurance premium. The insurance company can direct bill you on a monthly basis. Payroll deduction is not available for these premium payments.
