

How Can I Help?

School Assistance

Pre-School through High School

- Meet with your children's teacher or administrator in either a public or private school
- Attend a school function in which your children are participating
- Perform volunteer work approved by any teacher or administrator to assist a public school

Volunteer Service

- Provide voluntary service as part of an organized project sponsored by a community, national, or service organization
- Examples: donate blood, deliver meals to the elderly, attend non-profit board and committee meetings, volunteer for Scouts, Big Brother/Big Sister or other non-profit organization
- Serve on Volunteer fire departments and rescue squads

How Much Time Do I Have?

- 16 hours per year for full-time classified staff and admin/professional faculty (pro-rated for part-time)
- An additional 8 hours per year if you serve with a volunteer fire department, rescue squad or auxiliary unit
- Can use it in one hour increments or more
